

Jesus Shows the Disciples Who He Is

BIBLE PASSAGE: Mark 9:1-13

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Where did Jesus take Peter, James and John? (High up on a mountain top)
- What happened to Jesus? (He was shining so brightly)
- Who did the disciples see there with Jesus? (Moses and Elijah)
- Who spoke up when he was terrified and didn't know what to say? (Peter)
- What did God say to the disciples? ("This is my beloved Son; listen to him.")
- What did Jesus know He had to do for us? (Die for our sins)
- How do you listen to Jesus?
- What are you going to do this week to hear the voice of Jesus?
- Do you trust that Jesus does all things well? How can you show that you trust in Him?
- What did today's story teach you about Jesus and who He is?

BIBLE LEARNING ACTIVITIES

Recall the Bible Story

Things you need: "Mark 9" coloring page and Crayons

As your child colors, ask them if they can think of a time when they were so shocked that they were speechless. Talk about what it must have been like for the disciples.

*On the Mountain Top

Things you need: "On the Mountain Top" crossword printout and a pencil

Talk with your child as they choose the words to fill in the crossword puzzle. Make sure that they understand what the scripture taught us today.

*Team Walk

Things you need: a flashlight

One child can be designated as the leader with a flashlight and everyone else will go hide. As children and parents hide, the flashlight leader will shine the light on someone he/she finds. Once the light hits them, the hidden player will have to hold hands with the leader, making a chain as everyone is found. They will have to stay close to each other as they hunt for more, just as we must stay close to Jesus and walk with Him every day!

*Celebrate DAD

Things you need: "Super Hero" printable

Make Dad KING for the day. Let him sleep in. Bring him coffee in bed and maybe even let him have some alone time. Let him pick the menu for dinner and have him pick the movie. Have your child write/draw pictures of things they like to do with their Dad. Most importantly, remind him that he is doing a great job as a dad.

Things you need: Nothing

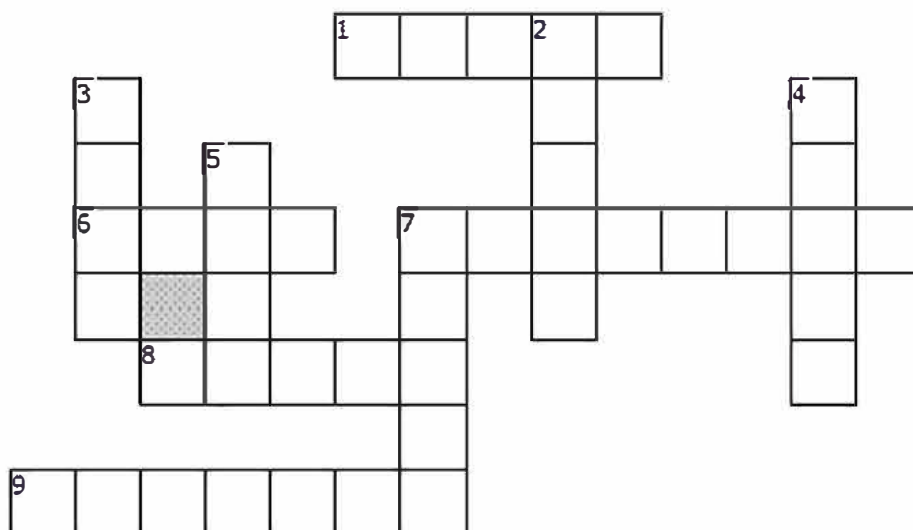
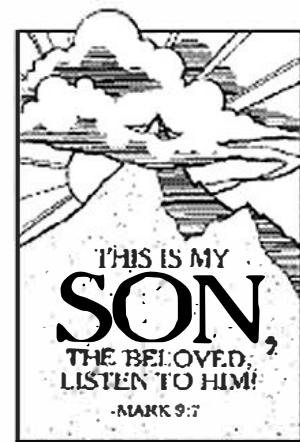
Take time praying as a family for the dads in your life. Thank God for the people He has given you and the blessings that dads are.
