Jesus is Alive!

BIBLE PASSAGE: Mark 16

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. How long had it been since Jesus died when the women came to visit? (three days)
- 2. What did the women find inside the tomb? (An Angel)
- 2. What did the angel tell the women? (Jesus had risen from the dead; to go tell the disciples)
- 3. Did the disciples believe Mary and the other friends when they said they had seen Jesus? (No)
- 4. When did the disciples believe that Jesus was alive? (When Jesus appeared to them.)
- 5. What is the Good News? (Answers may vary-Jesus is the Good News, what He did for us)
- 6. What do we learn about Jesus from our lesson today? (Answers may vary...He is our Savior, He gave us a way to be with God forever, He paid the price for our sin, he was dead, but now He is alive)

*Recall the Bible story

Things you need: "Alleluia-CP" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

*Easter Surprise Word Search

Things you need: "Easter Surprise Word Search" word search and pencil or crayon Encourage your child to find words from today's Bible story. Ask them if there are words that they do not understand or ask your child to explain some of the word meanings to you in their own thoughts.

*Activity Sheets

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets. Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.

*Going Deeper

Things you need: "Thanksgiving Coloring" sheet – 1 per Thanksgiving dinner guest printed on cardstock or plain paper, possibly reinforced with construction paper

Usually, we talk about Jesus and His resurrection on Easter Sunday. How perfect that we are learning about it right now, the week before we celebrate Thanksgiving! Take the opportunity to celebrate what we can really be thankful for — Jesus is alive! We encourage you to print out the coloring sheet for each of your Thanksgiving guests, have your child color them and use them as personalized place cards. Your guests can even write something that they are thankful for on them by their names. The holiday may look different this year for many but when we focus on what Jesus has done for us at the cross and His resurrection, our perspective will be changed to what is "kingdom thinking". Take time at your table this week to talk about how Jesus changes us to look more like Him day by day and how He has given us life for now and eternity. Then, give thanks "for His indescribable gift" . (2 Corinthians 9:15)


*Pray


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An Easter Surprise



- 6. The whole physical structure that forms a person




