#### **God Gives Me Peace**

#### **BIBLE PASSAGE:**

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Who wrote the letter in our lesson today? (Paul)
- 2. Where was Paul when he wrote the letter to the Philippians? (Jail)
- 3. True or False? Paul was very sad and gloomy because he was in jail. (False-God knew where Paul was)
- 4. What does Paul tell us in Philippians 4:4? (To rejoice in the Lord always!)
- 5. How can you be joyful even when things are tough? (Answers may vary)
- 6. What should we do when we start to worry? (Philippians 4:6-7: Don't worry, tell God about everything, ask and pray and give thanks to Him)
- 7. In Philippians 4:13, what does it say that God gives us? (Strength)
- 8. What do we learn about who God is in our lesson today? (Answers may vary)

#### \*Recall the Bible story

Things you need: "Pray Verse" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

### \*Writing My Prayers

Things you need: "Prayer+Reminders" page and a pencil or crayon

Talk about different prayers your child may have for themselves and others in their lives. If they cannot write in words, have them draw ideas in pictures. Encourage them to post their prayers somewhere they will see and be reminded about praying for those specific requests each day.

#### \*Activity Sheets

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets.

Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.


#### \*Celebrate!

Things you need: hat template printed on cardstock or construction paper, scissors, tape and decorative items such as buttons, pompons, markers

Cut out the hat template and fold the tab into the opening. Tape slot inside the hat to secure it. Encourage your child to decorate it as they would like. Talk about how we have great reason to celebrate just like in our video this week. God has given us peace through Jesus!

#### **Pray**

Pray with your child about the things that are important to them. The "Prayer+Reminders" activity sheet is a great way to talk with your child about their concerns for themselves and others. The "5 Finger Prayer" is another great way to remind us of what we want to pray while praying. Begin early in teaching them to take their prayers to God. He can handle their fears, and yours. He can supply us with the peace we need in our souls that the world's solutions fail to provide. Remind yourself in prayer of His character and His attributes. He is your Redeemer, sovereign, love, your refuge and so much more!










