BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 2:15-3:24 Adam and Eve Disobey God

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. What was our story about today? (The Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve breaking God's rule and sin separating us from God.)
- 2. God said that Adam and Eve could eat the fruit of all the trees but one. Which one was forbidden? (*The tree of the knowledge of good and evil*)
- 3. Why do you think God made this rule? (To protect them from knowing about evil)
- 4. What did God say would happen if they ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil? (They would die)
- 5. What happened when Adam and Eve disobeyed God? (God made them leave the beautiful garden, life got much harder and now they were separated from God.)
- 6. What is sin? (Sin is anything we do, anything we say, and anything we think that displeases God)
- 7. What does today's lesson teach us about God? (Answers will vary)

*Recall the Bible story

Things you need: "God Cared for Adam and Eve" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

*Word Search

Things you need: "Adam & Eve in the Garden" word search page and a pencil or crayon Find words from our Bible story today. Talk about any words that your child does not understand.

*Activity Sheets

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets.

Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.

*Laundry Toss

Things you need: Grab a laundry basket and bean bag or sock filled with rice.

Place the basket several feet away from your child. Have your child try to toss the bean bag into the basket. Use this game as an opportunity to explain the concept of sin and how no matter how hard we try, we all "miss the mark". We can never be perfect and hit the target every time. The good news is that Jesus is perfect and because He died for our sins, we can be forgiven.

*Pray

Pray for God to show you when you sin. He may tell you while reading your Bible, when your parents correct you or when you feel bad for doing something you know you should not have done – even if no one else knows about it. Tell Him you are sorry that you sinned against Him and ask Jesus to forgive you. Ask Him to help you to not sin the same way again. And remember how much He loves you!


