

BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 13
Abram Solved a Quarrel

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Who was Lot? *(Abram's nephew-Abram had not been renamed "Abraham" yet)*
2. Who quarreled about using the land? *(Abram's workers and Lot's workers)*
3. Why did Abram and Lot separate? *(They needed more land for their animals to graze on)*
4. What choice did Abram give Lot? *(To choose which part of the land he wanted)*
5. What choice did Lot make? *(Lot chose the best land)*
6. What did God promise Abram after Lot left? *(To give him all the land he could see)*
7. What does today's lesson teach us about God? *(Answers will vary)*

***Recall the Bible story**

Things you need: "Abram Lot coloring sheet" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

***Coding**

Things you need: "Lot's Choice" page and a pencil or crayon

Be a Bible sleuth and decode the message about where Lot chose to move.

***Activity Sheets**

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets.

Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.

***Opposite Simon Says**

Things you need: Someone to be "Simon".

Play the classic game of "Simon Says" but put a twist of opposites in it. When you tell your child to "jump up", they should "jump down". Continue game with right and left instructions, backwards and forwards, etc.

***Pray**

Pray that God will help you love your family and put others in your family first. For example, when mom brings home cookies, let your brother or sister take the first one. Let your dad enjoy his football game before playing a wrestling game with you. Choose to clean up your room like mom asked the first time she asks you. It's hard sometimes to put others first, but it is what God did by sending Jesus to die for our sins so we could live forever with Him.

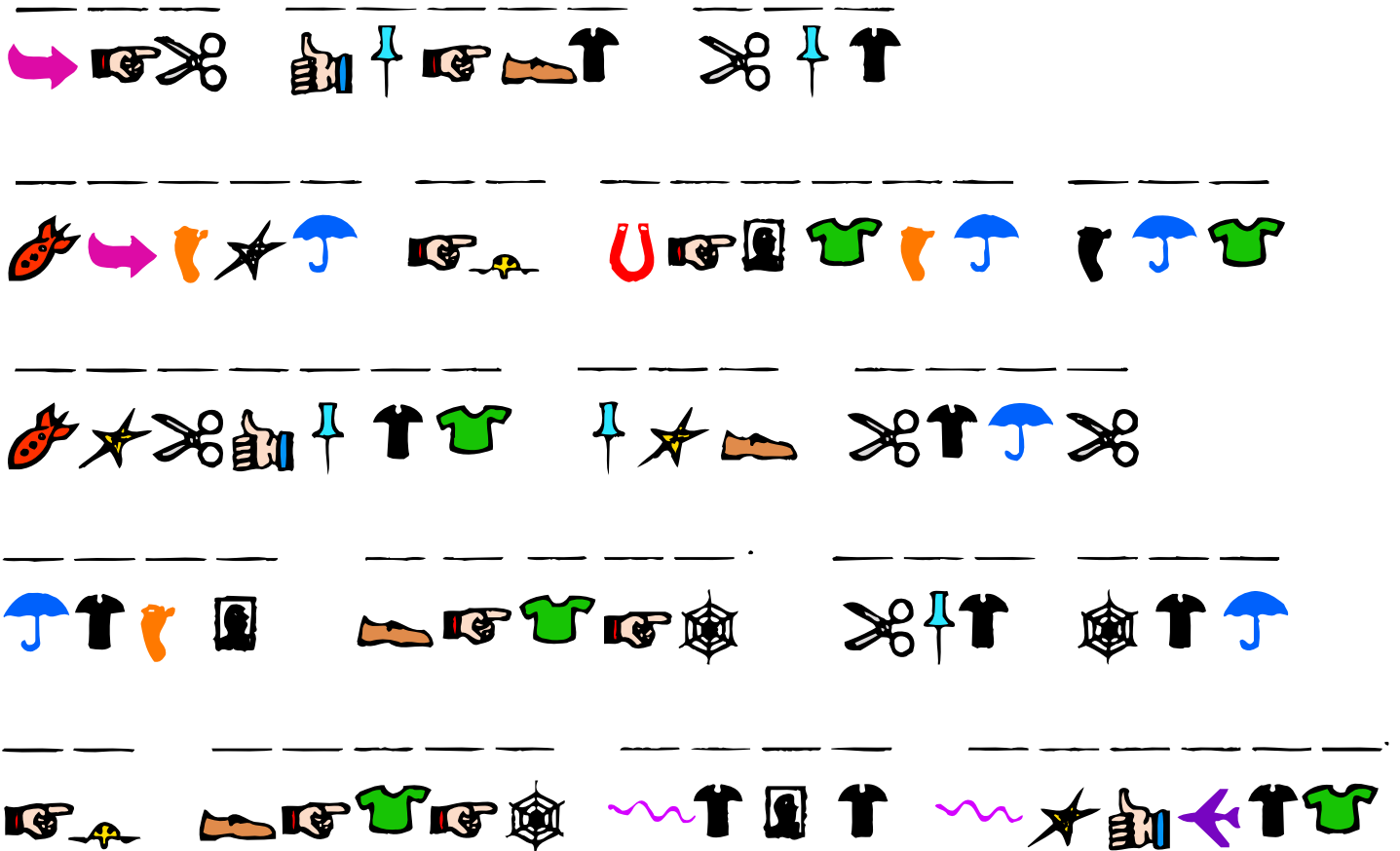
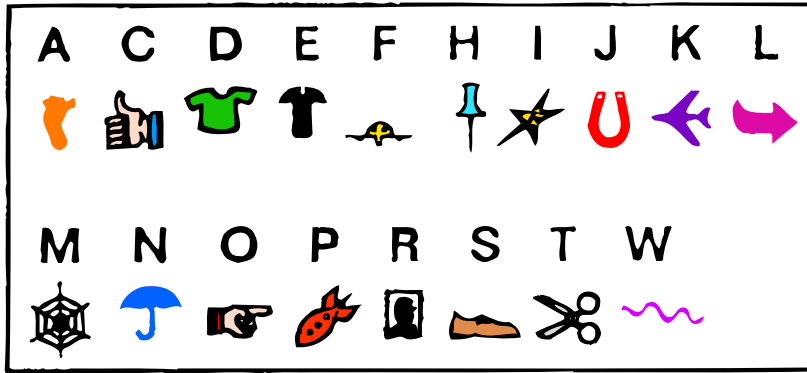
