BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 25:27-34; 27; 32; 33:1-11

Jacob and Esau Make Peace

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. How did Esau feel after Jacob tricked him? (He was so angry he wanted to hurt/kill Jacob))
- 2. What did God say to Jacob before he went home? (God would be with him)
- 3. What did Esau do when he heard Jacob was to return home? (He came to meet him with 400 men)
- 4. How did Jacob try to gain favor with Jacob? (Jacob sent gifts of animals)
- 5. How did Jacob feel when he heard Esau was coming with 400 men? (Afraid)
- 6. What did Esau do when he finally came to Jacob? (Ran to him, hugged, kissed, made peace with each other)
- 7. How did God make peace with us? (Sent Jesus to die for our sins so that we could live in eternity with Him)
- 8. What do we learn about God in our lesson today? (Answers will vary)

*Recall the Bible story

Things you need: "Jacob Esau Peace" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

*Word Search

Things you need: "Love One Another" word search page and a pencil or crayon Look for words related to our Bible verse for the month of February.

*Activity Sheets

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets. Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.

*Wall of Love

Things you need: Heart shaped post-its or cut out hearts, large paper or poster board, tape
Create a wall of love in your home during the month of February. Help your child write or draw things that
they can do or say to show love to others, in your home and elsewhere, to share the love of Jesus. The wall
will serve as a reminder to love others, as Jesus has loved us, all month long!




