

Jesus Taught Two Disciples

BIBLE PASSAGE: Luke 24:13-35

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Where were the 2 disciples traveling to? (Emmaus)
2. What were the 2 disciples talking about as they walked together? (Everything that had happened to Jesus in the past few days)
3. Did the 2 disciples recognize Jesus when He joined them on the road? (No)
4. What did Jesus teach them as He walked with the 2 disciples on the road? (Everything that the Scripture taught about Him)
5. When they arrived at Emmaus, what did the 2 disciples invite Jesus to do? (Stay with them longer)
6. When did the 2 disciples recognize Jesus? (When He blessed and broke the bread at their table)
7. What did Jesus do when the 2 disciples recognized Him? (He disappeared)
8. What did the 2 disciples tell the disciples back in Jerusalem? (That Jesus really had been raised from the dead)
9. What is one thing that you learned about Jesus in our lesson today?

*Recall the Bible story

Things you need: "Jesus Lives CP" coloring page and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

*The Road to Emmaus

Things you need: "Road Emmaus WS" word search and pencil or crayon

Have your child look for words from our Bible story in Luke. Talk about any words that your child does not understand.

Things you need: Print the additional activity sheets.

Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.

*Living it Out/Pray

Today we talked about two men that saw Jesus after He was raised to life (resurrected). At first, they didn't recognize Him. Maybe they expected Him to look a certain way or maybe they were not quite sure that He had been raised. We are not completely sure what was going on in their minds. Jesus told them all about Himself from the Bible. Today, we can read our Bibles and learn about Jesus. When we do not understand something about Jesus, we can pray and ask Him to show us. It's okay to not know everything about Jesus. We won't understand it all until we live with Him one day, if we have given our hearts to Him. If you have questions about Jesus, ask a parent or someone from church to help you answer that question. Jesus loves you and wants you to believe in Him.

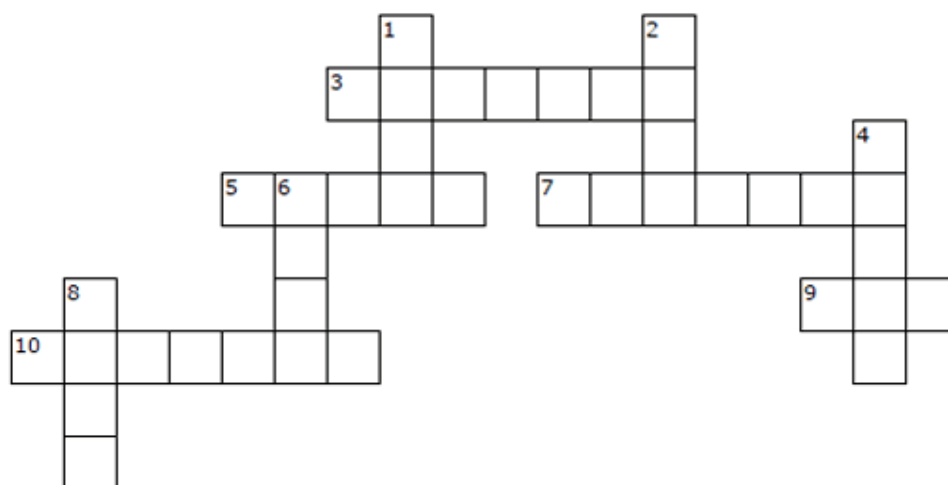

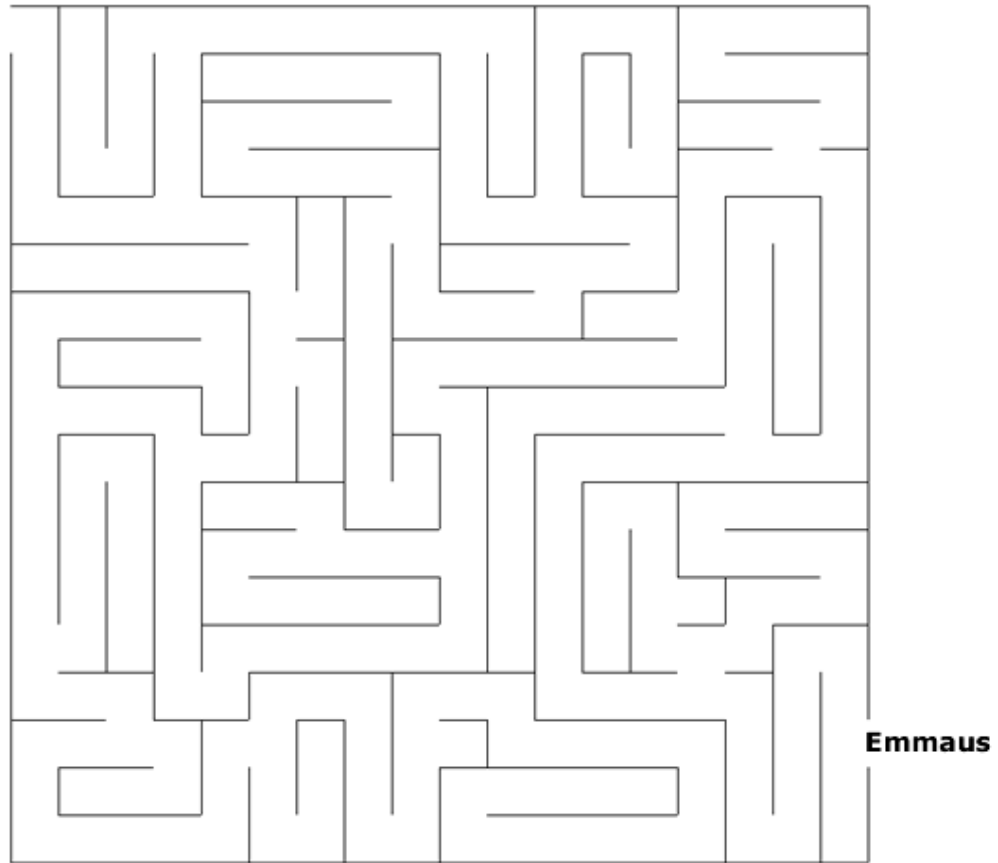
