

Jesus Heals a Man with Unclean Spirits

BIBLE PASSAGE

Mark 5:1-20

***FAMILY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- What did Jesus do for the man that asked for help?
He sent the unclean spirit away from the man – He healed him
- Where did the unclean spirit go?
Jesus sent them into the pigs nearby
- What did Jesus tell the man to do now that he was healed?
Go and tell everyone what Jesus had done for him
- What did today's story teach you about God and how wonderful He is?
- How does this story make you love God more?
- How can I show God how much I love Him?

BIBLE LEARNING ACTIVITIES

*** Jesus sent the unclean spirits to the Pigs**

Things you need: print out of PIG sheet, scissors, glue, and crayons (optional, hole punch and string)

First, have your child color the shapes, then if needed, help your child cut out the shapes. Glue the shapes together to make a pig. If you have the supplies, punch a hole in the top and add some string so that your child can hang their pig.

You can say: In the scripture today we learned that the unclean spirits begged God to allow them to go into the pigs. God said yes to their request. Let's create a pig together. This pig can remind us that God wants to take the bad things away for us too. He loves us so much!

* Jesus the Savior

Things you need: Jesus the Savior color sheet

As your child colors, have them talk to you about what they learned in the lesson. Or maybe even have them color as you go through the discussion questions.

*Jesus Has Power Over Evil

Things you need: Playdoh, Clay, or 2 solo cups, foil, and some glue, other craft supplies around the house

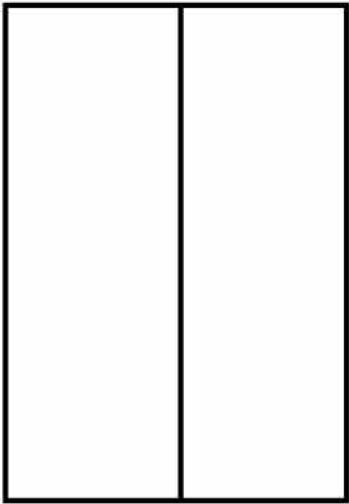
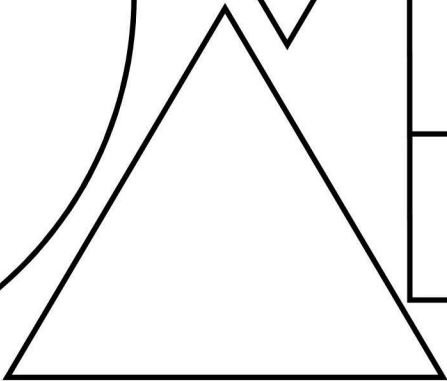
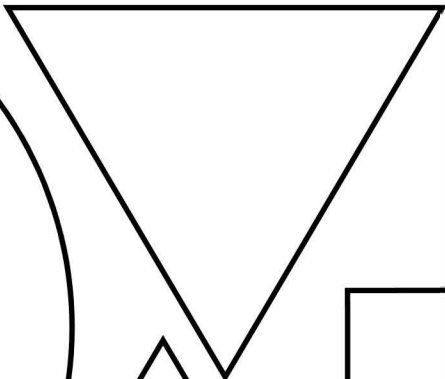
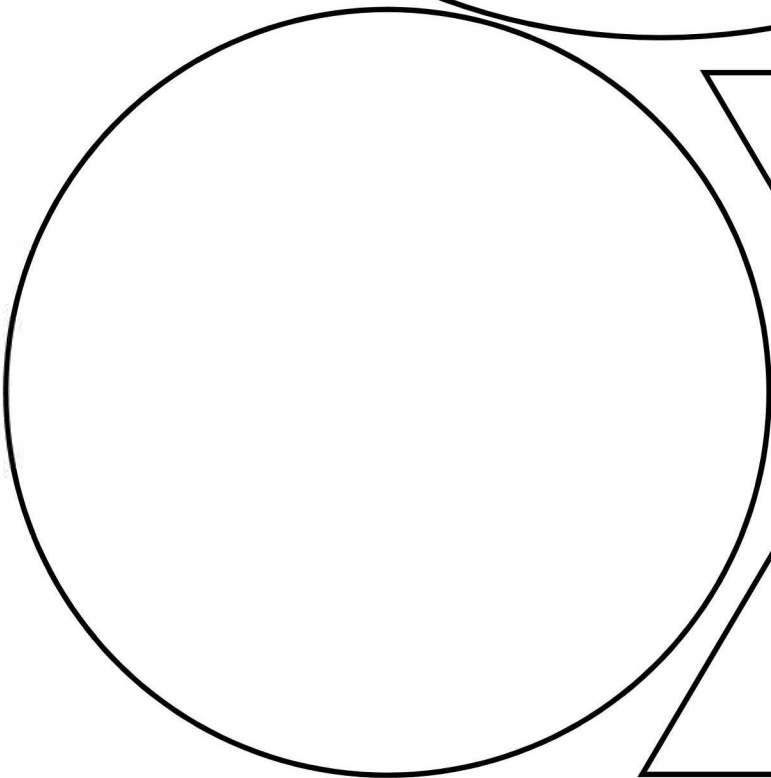
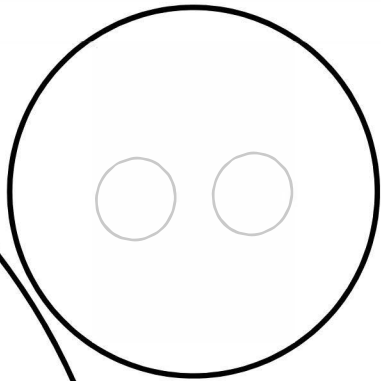
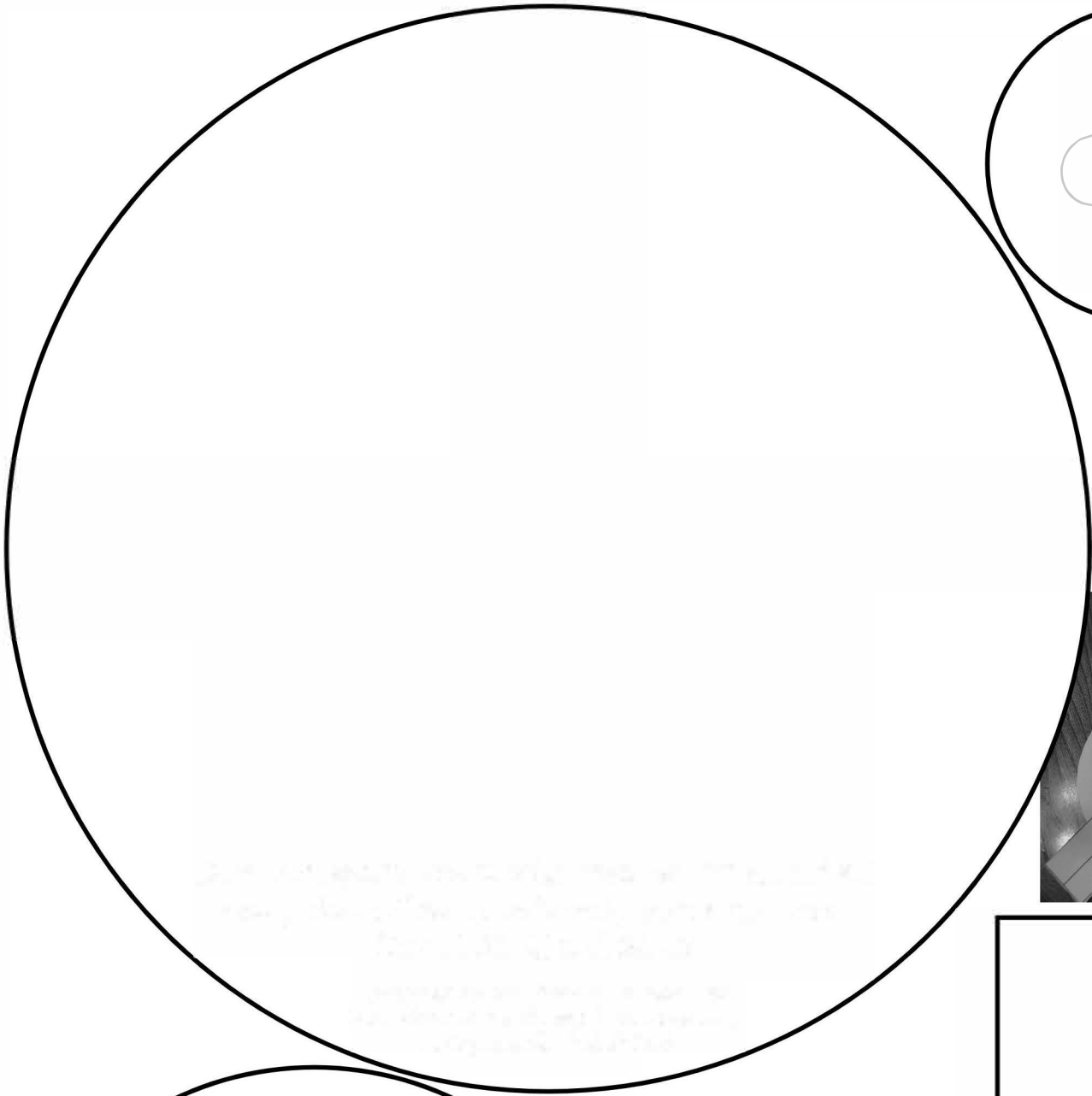
Let your child know that we will be using the supplies that you have to make a trophy for God. You can use Playdoh or clay to shape the trophy. If you have 2 solo cups, you can wrap them in foil and glue or tape the bottoms together to make a trophy. If you have pipe cleaners, use them for handles. These are just ideas, GET CRAFTY! If you choose this option, have your child write on a little strip of paper JESUS WINS and glue it to the bottom.

You can say: Jesus is Lord over all things, good and evil. This means whenever there's a battle between good and evil, Jesus always wins!

Things you need: Print out of Jesus Drives out a demon circle word sheet and a pencil

Print out the circle word for those old enough to do this activity and have them find some key words from the Bible story today.
